- Technology evaluation and recommendation: Collaborate with cross-functional teams to evaluate and recommend new hardware, software, and network technologies that align with BCBP's IT strategy and business needs and requirements.
- Performance optimization: Monitor system and network performance, conduct performance tuning, and optimizing resource utilization to enhance overall efficiency.
- Continuous learning and development: Stay up to date with industry trends, best practices, protocols, and emerging technologies to continually enhance BCBP's IT infrastructure.
- Issue diagnosis and resolution: Diagnose and resolve network and system issues, including hardware, software, and connectivity problems, in a timely and efficient manner.
- Auditing and Vulnerability Management: Conduct regular system and network audits to identify vulnerabilities and areas for improvement and take appropriate corrective action.
- Documentation management: Maintain documentation for system configurations, network diagrams, and standard operating procedures (SOPs).
- End-User support: Provide technical support and guidance to end-users, assisting with troubleshooting and resolving IT-related issues.
