CIRCULAR NO. 2026/001

SUBJECT: Public Access to the Undesirable Aliens List

The Bureau of Customs and Border Protection (“BCBP”) issues this Circular to inform the public that the Republic of Palau’s Undesirable Aliens List is publicly accessible on the Bureau’s official website.

The purpose of this Circular is to ensure that Palauan citizens, businesses, employers, landlords, service providers, and other members of the community are aware that individuals listed on the Undesirable Aliens List are prohibited from entering the Republic of Palau. Persons appearing on the List are not eligible for admission into the country, and any existing or prospective business, employment, contractual, or other arrangements should be undertaken with this restriction clearly in mind.

Public access to the Undesirable Aliens List is intended to promote transparency and to allow members of the community to make informed decisions in their dealings, while supporting the Republic’s efforts to safeguard border integrity, public safety, and national security.

The Bureau also reminds the public that inclusion on, or removal from, the Undesirable Aliens List is governed by a formal review and recommendation process established by Executive Order No. 497, which is designed to ensure consistency, procedural fairness, and due deliberation across relevant government agencies. The List is not maintained arbitrarily, and decisions are made through a structured process culminating in final determination by the President
